

EXTRACT FROM 1905 KELLYS DIRECTORY OF SUSSEX

SHOREHAM.

SHOREHAM is a seaport, comprising the parishes of New and Old Shoreham, situated at the mouth of the river Adur, and has a junction station of the Horsham branch with the coast line of the London, Brighton and South Coast railway, 56½ miles from London, 6 west from Brighton, 22 east from Chichester, 5 east from Worthing, in the Mid division of the county, Fishersgate hundred, Brighton county court district, rape of Bramber, Steyning petty sessional division and union, rural deanery of Lewes (second division), archdeaconry of Lewes and diocese of Chichester. Shoreham returned two members to Parliament from 1 Edward I. (1272), but under the provisions of the "Redistribution of Seats Act, 1885" (48 & 49 Vict. c. 23), the representation was merged into that of the county. The "Local Government Act, 1858" was adopted here 6 Dec. 1865, when a local board was formed; but under the "Local Government Act, 1894" (56 and 57 Vict. c. 73), the town is now governed by an Urban District Council of 12 members. The town is lighted with gas conveyed from Hove, and is supplied with water by the Brighton Corporation, from works at Old Shoreham, where there are "two reservoirs, the higher one capable of holding 80,000 gallons and the lower 90,000. An elegant suspension bridge, carrying the road to Worthing over the river Adur, was erected in 1832 by the Duke of Norfolk. Old and New Shoreham are both on the Eastern bank of this river; the former, once a place of some importance, being half a mile north of the new town. Ella, the first king of the South Saxons, landed here to complete the conquest of England, and Charles II. made his escape from Shoreham to Fecamp after the battle of Worcester. A battery (No. 12) is placed at the mouth of the river. By an order dated August 9th, 1881, the limits of the port were defined as commencing at the eastern part of Rottingdean, being the western boundary of the port of Newhaven, and extending along the coast of Sussex in a westerly direction to the western part of Heene, that being the eastern boundary of the port of Littlehampton.

The church of St. Mary the Virgin, New Shoreham, is part only of an ancient and beautiful cruciform structure of flint and stone, of which nearly the whole of the nave has been destroyed, and is an extremely interesting specimen of Transitional Norman architecture, including a tower containing a clock and 8 bells, the clock being the gift of the Rev. R. P. Hooper: the eastern windows and others are stained, and there are brasses with effigies: the church was repaired in 1876, and in 1896 the tower was restored and 4 of the bells re-cast at a cost of upwards of £2,000, and affords 600 sittings. The register dates from the year 1566. The living is a vicarage, reunited in 1897 to that of St. Nicholas, Old Shoreham. joint net yearly value £500, with residence, in the gift of Magdalen College, Oxford, and held since 1894 by the Rev. Charles Marsh Ainslie Tower M.A. of that college.

The church of .St. Nicholas, Old Shoreham, is of stone, portions being of Norman date, and it comprises a tower containing one bell: there is a brass to Capt. Richard Poole, 1652, and to Thomas, his son, 1652: the east window and others are stained, and there are screens of carved oak: the church was repaired in 1845, and affords 200 sittings, The register dates from the year 1723.

The Catholic church, dedicated to St. Peter, is of flint with stone dressings, in the Gothic style of the 13th century, and was opened in 1875, at a total cost of about £5,000: there are 200 sittings; the Presbytery adjoining was completed in 1877.

There is a Congregational chapel, founded in 1800, with 250 sittings, a Baptist chapel, erected in 1870, seating 350 persons, also Wesleyan, Primitive Methodist and Particular Baptist chapels.

Here is a private Grammar School, established in 1842; Mr. S. Gregory-Taylor, principal.

The trade of the port is chiefly in coals, corn, general cargo and timber, and yacht building is also carried on.

The Town hall, formerly the Custom House, was leased to the Local Board, now the Urban District Council, in 1890.

The old Steyning Workhouse stands in Ham road.

A cemetery, of nearly 2 acres in extent, with a mortuary chapel, was formed in 1887, at a cost of about £2,000, and is under the control of the Urban District Council, acting as the burial board.

The No. 8 Company of the 1st Sussex Royal Garrison Artillery (Volunteers) has its orderly room in High street.

The Swiss gardens, in Victoria road, were opened in 1838, and contain a large theatre holding 1,300 persons; a ball room 150 feet long by 54 broad; a refreshment room, museum and conservatory. These are now (1905) closed, but there is a lake in the grounds which is occasionally used for fishing.

Buckingham House, Old Shoreham, the property of H. Bridger Esq. J.P. but at present occupied by Henry Head Esq. J.P. is a modern residence standing in pleasant grounds, a short distance north of the town. The Duke of Norfolk K.G. is lord of the manor. The principal landowners are Harry Bridger Esq. in Old Shoreham and the Rev. Robert Poole Hooper M.A. (of 31 Cambridge road, Brighton) in New Shoreham. The area of Old Shoreham is 1,923 acres of land, 21 of tidal water and 25 of foreshore; rateable value, £5,638; New Shoreham,

134 acres of land, 1 of water, 19 of tidal water and 97 of foreshore; rateable value, £12,971. The population in 1901 was, Old Shoreham, 281; New Shoreham, 3,818, including officers and inmates in Steyning union workhouse.
