

## SHOREHAM-BY-SEA

INCLUDING BUNGALOW TOWN

SHOREHAM-BY-SEA is a seaport at the mouth of the river Adur; it comprises the Parish of New and part of that of Old Shoreham, has a junction station of the Horsham branch with the coast line of the Southern railway (L.B. and S.C. section), and is 56½ miles from London, 6 west from Brighton, 22 ( east from Chichester, 5 east from Worthing, in the Horsham and Worthing division of the county of Sussex, Fishersgate hundred, Brighton county court district, rape of Bramber, petty sessional division of Steyning, rural deanery of Hove, archdeaconry of Lewes and diocese of Chichester. Shoreham returned two members to Parliament from 1 Edward I. (1272), but under the provisions of the Re-distribution of Seats Act, 1885 (48 & 49 Vict. c. 23), the representation was merged into that of the county. The Local Government Act, 1858, was adopted here 6th December, 1865, when a local board was formed; but under the provisions of the Local Government Act, 1894 (56 & 57 Viet. c. 73), the town is now governed by an Urban District Council, consisting of fifteen members. By Local Government Board Order No. 54.313, which came into operation October 1st., 1910, parts of Lancing, Old Shoreham and Kingston-by-Sea were added to the Urban District, which was renamed Shoreham-by-Sea; by a farther Order No. 71,927, of 1927, part of the parish of Lancing, in the rural district of Steyning West, was transferred to the urban district of Shoreham-by-Sea; the district comprises that town, Bungalow Town and Kingston- by-Sea, and is divided into North, South, Marine and Kingston-by-Sea wards. Under the West Sussex Review Order 1933 the remainder of the Parish of Old Shoreham was transferred to the Shoreham-by-Sea Urban District. There is a bridge over the river Adur. The original bridge, built in 1832, was found to be not strong enough for present-day traffic, and a new bridge was opened by Lord Leconfield in 1923. It is a steelwork structure consisting of four spans of riveted bowstring girders. The road

over the bridge directly connects Brighton, Hove and' Shoreham with Worthing, Littlehampton, Arundel and Chichester. The town is lighted with gas and supplied by the Brighton, Hove and Worthing Gas Company conveyed from Hove, and supplied with water by the Brighton Corporation from works situated at Old Shoreham, where there are two reservoirs, the higher one capable of holding 80,000 gallons and the lower 90,000. Electric light and power is also supplied by the Shoreham and District Electric Lighting and Power Co. Ltd. who obtain their supply in bulk from the Brighton Corporation. Old Shoreham, once a place of some importance, is half a mile north of the new town. Ella, the first king of the South Saxons, landed here to complete the conquest of England, and Charles II. made his escape from Shoreham to Fécamp after the battle of Worcester. By an order dated August 9th, 1881, the limits of the port were defined as commencing at the eastern part of Rottingdean, being the western boundary of the port of Newhaven, and extending along the coast of Sussex in a westerly direction to the western part of Heene, that being the eastern boundary of the port of Littlehampton. The trade of the port is chiefly in bricks, coals, corn, general cargo, timber and cement; yacht building is also carried on.

The church of St. Mary de Haura, New Shoreham, dating from 1100, is part only of an ancient and beautiful cruciform structure, of which nearly the whole of the nave has been destroyed; it is an extremely interesting specimen of late Norman and Transitional architecture of flint and stone; it consists of a chancel of five bays with blind-storey and clerestory and aisles, one bay only of the nave, transepts and a lofty central tower (which was restored in 1896), containing a clock, the gift of the Rev. R. P. Hooper, and 8 bells, four of which were recast in 1896 and three new added, one being the gift of the late Ellman Brown esq. a native of the town, and another of T. Dyer-

Edwardes esq. whose father was a great benefactor to the church: the roof is groined and the inside walls are beautifully ornamented with the dog-tooth and zigzag patterns: there are piscinæ in both transepts; the only remaining bay of the nave has a three-light Perpendicular window; the main entrance is through an arch in the late Norman style, profusely decorated with the carving peculiar to that period: the east end is lighted by three windows, above which are three lancet windows, surmounted by a wheel window, all filled with stained glass, as is the west window, together with the Norman windows in the chancel aisles and other parts of the church: in the east wall three lower windows are filled with stained glass; these and other enrichments of the east end of the church were carried out as a memorial to Capt. H. B. Hooper by his widow. On the chancel floor are brass effigies of a man and woman, each with the hands crossed upon the breast, date about 1450: another brass with arms, in the floor near the pulpit, bears the following inscription: "Heere lyeth interred the body of Walter West, of Woodman Cote, in the covnty of Svssex, esq. who married Elizabeth, the eldest davgkter of Thomas Shirley, of Preston, in the covnty of Svssex, esq. who dyed Jvly the 18th, Ao. Dni. 1648, aged 23 yeares:' there is a brass tablet with an inscription recording the gift of £1,000 from T. Dyer Edwardes esq. with an account of the works therewith carried out in the church in 1876. In 1920 a brass was erected in the south-east aisle, memory of those connected with the parish who fell in the Great War, 1914-18: a stone tablet to the officers and men of the 72nd Infantry Brigade was erected at the same time by Major-Gen. Bertram R. Mitford C.B., C.M.G., F.S.O. who had commanded the Brigade. In the churchyard is a stone cross erected in 1925 by Frederic Lennard esq. in memory of his son and men of the town who fell in the Great War 1914-18. The register dates from the year 1566. The living is a vicarage, held with that of St. Nicholas, Old Shoreham, joint net yearly value £467 with residence; it is in the gift of Magdalen College, Oxford, and has been held since 1922 by the Rev. John Francis Gilderoy Glossop M.A. of that college.

Originally a Saxon church dating back to about 900 and the oldest church in Sussex, the church of St. Nicholas, Old Shoreham, is a cruciform building of flint with stone dressings, the fine arches in the tower and other features being of Norman date; it consists of a chancel, transepts, nave, north chapel, and a central tower containing one bell: under a canopy in the south wall of the chancel is a brass inscribed to Captain Richard Poole, of this parish, *ob.* 17 Sept. 1652, and to Thomas, his only son, *ob.* 15 Nov. 1652; around is a decorated border, and at the top are the arms of the family, with the legend "Tvtamen devs:" near this is a piscina: the east window and others in the chancel are stained, and the chancel is divided from the nave by a screen of carved oak: the church was repaired in 1845; there are 200 sittings. The register dates from the year 1566. The living is a vicarage, joint net yearly value £467; it is in the gift of Magdalen College, Oxford, and has been held (jointly with that of St. Mary's) since 1922 by the Rev. John Francis Gilderoy Glossop M.A. of that college.

ST. GILES, Shoreham is an ecclesiastical district and was formed in 1934. The church, which stands in Upper Shoreham road at the corner of Park avenue, is a redbrick building with nave, chancel and vestry. It was built in 1906 and was formerly used almost exclusively as a chapel for Southlands Hospital. With the development of the new residential district, however, it was opened as the parish church of the new district in 1934. There is a memorial to the relatives and friends of residents in this parish who fell in the Great War, unveiled on Armistice Day 1934. The living is of the net yearly value of, £350. It is in the gift of the Bishop of Chichester and has been held since 1934 by the Rev. John Southey Combridge A.K.C.

The church of the Good Shepherd, Bungalow Town, consecrated in July 1913, is a brick building with a tower and west porch, The Rev. Rt. Chas. Filler, M.A. is curate in charge.

The Roman Catholic church of St. Peter is an edifice of flint with stone dressings, in the Gothic style of the 13th century; it was opened in 1875, and consists of a nave and a Lady

chapel on the north side: the total cost was defrayed by the Dowager Duchess of Norfolk: there are 200 sittings: there is a Presbytery adjoining.

The Convent of the Sisters of Mercy, in West Street, is a brick building with stone dressings, of modern design, finished in 1903,

The Methodist church and Sunday school, in Brunswick road, were built in 1900, and seats about 350 persons: the Methodist church, in High street, was built in 1879 and has 200 sittings: the Congregational church was founded in 1800 and is one of the seven oldest Nonconformist churches in Sussex; the present building was erected in 1906 and has accommodation for 300 persons; it is built of brick and terra cotta: the style is Early English: the Particular Baptist chapel, in' John street, built in 1867, seats 200.

The Baptist chapel, with school adjoining, in the Western road, built in 1880, is an edifice of brick and flint, with dressing of Portland stone, in the Italian style, and will seat 350 persons.

The Town hall, formerly the Custom house, but reconstructed and enlarged, is the property of the Urban District Council. The old Steyning institution stands in Ham road, and is now occupied as Children's Homes. A Cemetery of nearly 2 acres in extent was formed in 1887.

The Marlipins Museum, in the High street, is an ancient building consisting of two storeys, the floor of the lower one being about 2 feet below the level of the street. The walls, 2 feet 5 inches thick, are built of flint rubble with a certain proportion of hard chalk; the original door and window dressings are for the be most part of Caen stone. The front elevation is mainly arranged in a chequer of squares composed of stone and "knapped," or snapped, flints, but this treatment ceases at the bottom of the gable, the latter being plastered. Its appearance suggests a building of the fourteenth century, but an examination of the interior reveals evidence of twelfth-century work—the oldest feature being a mutilated Norman window-opening which

retains the semi-circular internal arch and the stone dressings finishing at window-sill height. Externally this feature has been mutilated by a doorway which has been cut through the outer wall. In the front are two doorways with pointed arches, one leading down to the lower floor, and the other to stairs up to the floor above. Between the two doorways is a small pointed window-opening 18 inches wide, splaying to an inside width of 3 feet 4 inches and having a segment-shaped rear arch. The stonework of the outer window-case retains the holes for the iron grating which originally filled it. The massive timbering of the original roof is worthy of examination, and may be easily seen from the upper storey. The original purpose of the building is a matter of uncertainty. Some believe it to have been the properly of one of the religious houses which formerly flourished in Shoreham, others, that its use was entirely of a secular character, and that it was originally erected by the de Braose family, who, as lords of the town, exacted tolls from ships using the port and from merchants frequenting the market. Such tolls probably being paid in kind may have been stored here. The ancient building has been saved from destruction by a fund raised by public subscription. It is a trust managed by a local committee which on Oct. 20th, 1926, opened the building as the Marlipins Museum for the collection of antiquities of the town and neighbourhood. The adjacent licensed premises, known as the "Marlipins," stands on the site of an inn which was known as the "Ship."

The area of Shoreham-by-Sea Urban District is 1,706 acres. The population of Old Shoreham in 1931 was 15, and Shoreham-by-Sea in 1931 was 8,757.

KINGSTON-BY-SEA is a parish, half a mile west from Southwick station on the Brighton and Portsmouth section of the Southern Railway (L. B. & S. C. section), 1 mile east from Shoreham and 5 miles west from Brighton, in the Horsham and Worthing division of the county of Sussex, Fishersgate hundred, Bramber rape, urban district of Shoreham-by-Sea (to which it was added by Local

Government Board Order No. 54,317, which came into operation on October 1st, 1910), petty sessional division of Steyning, Brighton county court district, rural deanery of Hove, archdeaconry of Lewes and diocese of Chichester. Anciently called Kingston Buci, it is also mentioned in Domesday Book as Kingston or Chingestune forso; it received its name of Kingston Buci from Landric de Buci who held the land from William the Conqueror. The church of St. Julian is a building of flint and stone in the Early English style, and consists of a chancel, nave, north transept, south porch and a tower containing one ancient bell and a peal of modern tubular bells given by Brig.-Gen. Oswald Ball; it contains monuments to the families of Blaker, Dawson, Mills, Monke and Norton; the arms of the Lewknor family are to be seen on the rood screen and in one of the windows: the font is believed to be Norman; an ancient anchorite cell has been discovered in the north wall: there is a tomb of the Perpendicular period, reputed to be that of a member of the Lewknor family, on the north side of the sanctuary: there is also an ancient aumbry: a low-side window and a sundial were discovered in 1930: there are four memorial windows: an alabaster and marble tablet on the south wall of the nave, a 12th century doorway and a new vestry designed by Sir Giles G. Scott R.A. in memory of those connected with the parish who fell in the Great War, 1914-18: there are 200 sittings. The register dates from the year 1591. The living is a

rectory, net yearly value £481, with residence and 2 acres of glebe; it is in the gift of Lord Leconfield and has been held since 1930 by the Rev. Walter W. March M.A. of St. Catharine's College, Cambridge, who is hon. CF. The Church Parish hall, a building of red brick, was opened in 1911. Kingston is a place of considerable trade, being the principal station of the Southern Railway (L. B. & S. C. section) for goods and merchandise landed at Kingston wharf, in Shoreham harbour. There is a Customs House, removed from Shoreham in 1886, and also quays, belonging to the Southern Railway Company, besides timber ponds and large saw mills belonging to Messrs. Beves and Co. Ltd. of Brighton and extensive malting houses held by The Kemp Town Brewery. The lighthouse, erected in 1846, opposite the mouth of Shoreham harbour, stands in the centre of this parish, and opposite to it is a lifeboat station. The Steyning Institution was built in 1901 on the Old Shoreham road, at a cost of £65,000, for 480 inmates, and has attached 20 acres of ground, which are farmed by the inmates. The principal landowners are Lt.-Gen. Sir George Frederick Gorringe K.C.B., K.C.M.G., D.S.O. who is lord of the manor, and the trustees of the late Mrs. Louisa Gorringe. The area is 782 acres of land, 10 of tidal water and 19 of foreshore; a great part of the land on the southern portion of this parish is now used as market gardens and for fruit growing. The population in 1931 was 1,812
